Dear Pastoral & Ministerial Leadership,

Southwestern Christian College (SwCC) would like to invite your ministerial leadership, college bound scholars, and non-degree seeking lay persons to SwCC Preview Day on April 13, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 pm, located at 200 Bowser Cir., Terrell, Texas 75160. We will provide an 8:00 a.m. complimentary breakfast and noon lunch while offering campus tours, a financial aid workshop, and an admissions presentation on how to sign up for 100% on-line courses. We are also offering dormitory tours, as well as athletic and choir tryouts for scholars seeking a college education grounded in Christian experience.

SwCC Preview Day attendees will receive an admissions fee waiver as well as access to special scholarship opportunities. We will also provide gift bags for prospective scholar visitors, fun raffle giveaways, and you will be treated to performances by our internationally recognized and award winning acapella choir!

This is a chance for prospective scholars to see our newly renovated campus, meet our professors, and speak directly with ministers currently attending SwCC who can give them a first-hand perspective of the SwCC experience. We are asking that you share this information in your announcements and church bulletin.

Our Associate and Bachelor's in religious studies equips ministers and lay persons to understand the word of God by accurately discovering what Bible authors were saying to their first readers from their historical, grammatical, and cultural point of view. After examining the ancient context, we then learn to apply God's unchanging principles to ourselves first, then to our communities. Scholars learn how to commit to spiritual values, moral excellence, and are trained to assist in guiding the communities they will be serving to do the same. We also offer youth and adult education curriculum development as well as administration courses.

Please keep in mind that Southwestern Christian College offers a Local Incentive Scholarship to scholars who live within 60 miles of Terrell, TX and who also commute to campus. Once qualified for the program, Southwestern will accept a scholar's FAFSA as well as any additional grants they are able to receive, then waive the remainder of their tuition. From the vantage point of the family, the education is "free" to the scholar who will only need to cover costs such as books and fees.

To qualify for this scholarship, scholars must:

- complete their 2024-25 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- qualify for the Pell grant (they do not have to qualify for the maximum Pell amount)
- maintain a 2.0 GPA while enrolled at Southwestern Christian College
